The Chevrolet Chevy II/Nova was a small automobile manufactured by Chevrolet, and produced in five generations for the 1962 through 1979, and 1985 through 1988 model years. Nova was the top model in the Chevy II lineup through 1968. The Chevy II nameplate was dropped, Nova becoming the nameplate for the 1969 through 1979 models. Built on the X-body platform, the Nova was replaced by the 1980 ...The Chevrolet Impala (/ ɪ m ˈ p æ l ə , - ɪ p ˈ ɪ l ə /) is a full-size car built by Chevrolet for model years 1958 to 1985, 1994 to 1996, and since 2000 onwards as a mid-size car. The Impala is Chevrolet's popular flagship passenger car and is generally among the better selling American made automobiles in the United States. The SUV as we know it today was born in the mid-'80s, and one of the first models was the Chevrolet Blazer (introduced in 1983). Based on the Chevy S-10 truck engine and frame, the Blazer was a slightly smaller, more sporty choice for people who liked to go four-wheeling in a vehicle that could carry all their gear inside and didn't want to drive a huge truck like the Suburban.
