

# Download Lesson Plans The Ugly Duckling

The Ugly Duckling by Hans Christian Andersen is often used to help children with self-esteem and individuality. Besides this obvious lesson, you can use these lesson plans for The Ugly Duckling to reinforce reading and writing skills. One lesson is on setting and important character traits. The other lesson is on writing a compare/contrast paragraph. Your students have probably heard of The Ugly Duckling, but have they ever tried to put the events of the story in order? In this simple sequencing lesson, young readers match illustrations to text and put them into the proper order. The Ugly Duckling is a beloved Fairy Tale. Fairy tales are stories with imaginary characters that usually have a teachable lesson. Role playing can help the children understand the lesson (morals/values) and you may wish to do as part of the book introductions.
